Onella Michel, age 6 (right), looked out at the ruins of her school in Chambellan, Haiti. When the 7.2 magnitude earthquake shook the country in August of 2021, Onella was saved by the quick action of her mother, who grabbed her and ran to the street as soon as the shaking began.

The incredible and swift compassion of congregations like yours rushed more than 4,000 water purification tablets, 1,000 tarps for temporary shelter and LWR Quilts, Personal Care Kits and Baby Care Kits to neighbors like Onella and her family in the immediate days following the earthquake. And because Lutherans responded so generously, we also repaired damaged health clinics and replenished critical medical supplies for our neighbors in Haiti.
