# Your Caring Heart Reaches Neighbors in Crisis

The violent earthquake that struck on February 6 has killed tens of thousands of our neighbors in Türkiye (Turkey), and the death toll keeps rising. We've heard the heartbreaking stories of children who were saved from the quake's rubble only to learn that their parents had perished.

These children are now orphans — scared, alone and without the comforts of home.

The earthquake's devastation has uprooted the lives of many loving families who are now desperately trying to rebuild.

Thanks to the quick and generous support of so many of you, we were able to rush emergency aid to vulnerable and shocked earthquake survivors. Our swift response was critical because devastating aftershocks struck on February 20 and February 27, resulting in more casualties and destruction.

With your help, our ongoing response includes:

- Airlifting urgently needed supplies, like tents, tarps, winter clothing and solar lights.
- Coordinating with partners to distribute ready-to-eat food and hot meals, sleeping bags and sleeping mats.
- Shipping Lutheran World Relief Quilts, Baby Care Kits and Personal Care Kits.
- Meeting survivors on the front lines to share your love, prayers and support.
- Conducting needs assessments in affected areas.

report's production, our team members on the front lines are reporting that much of the population in Türkiye — children, families and seniors — are sheltering outside in tents while battling harsh temperatures that often fall below freezing. Hypothermia is a growing concern.



With you by our side, we will remain in Türkiye for the long haul and help with this shelter crisis. Along with our partners, we are helping to construct a container city with

500 homes near a hillside above the city of Kirikhan — one of the hardest-hit communities.

Each family's container will have two rooms: a bathroom with a flushing toilet, and a kitchen. Bathroom facilities are critical as civilians in tent-cities are sharing filthy porta-potties that are unsanitary and dangerous to public health. This new container city will also include 25 washing machines and clean running water.

Additionally, there will be a private garden area outside each container, so each family has an outdoor area to call their own. Larger designated play areas, where children can gather and play together, will also be created. Re-establishing some sort of normalcy for the little ones who are suffering is essential to helping to maintain good mental and physical health.

Thank you for rushing to the front lines with us during this life-shattering disaster and for remaining a loving neighbor as we support the recovery in Türkiye for years to come.

# Your Love Grows Healthy Food and Shares Lasting Knowledge

Kimberly, a pint-sized girl with big dreams of becoming a doctor, was hungry and in danger of contracting a deadly disease from drinking tainted water.

Fortunately, your love and support empowered Kimberly's mother, Irma, to obtain the knowledge and resources she needed to filter and purify water before sharing it with her family.

"It has helped my children's health and the health of all of us." Irma shares.

Kimberly is no longer starving for nutrients. Thanks to your generosity, Irma is now part of a women's group in her village of Las Majada in Tacaná, Guatemala, where she learns better farming practices. She currently grows healthy vegetables, such as carrots, beets, radishes and herbs, to feed her family.
